

Friends of ENCTU Sponsors' Raffle Prize

In honor of the late Ernie Nester, Ben Pinti, a TU member originally from West Virginia who now resides in Michigan is offering 2 guests, a 4 night stay at his cabin located on the South Branch of the Au Sable



River and just upstream from the famous "Mason Tract" property. George Mason who was president of the Nash Car Company donated this property to the State of Michigan upon his death in the 1950's, before his death George Mason is also recognized for inspiring his friend George Griffith to form a new organization to protect trout streams. In 1959 George Griffith fulfilled George Mason's dream with the creation of Trout Unlimited.

Ben's cabin near Roscommon, MI features 3 bedrooms & is located on the riverbank of the South Branch of the Au Sable near Chase Bridge. Each guest will have their own bedroom, Ben will also provide dinner for the 2 guests for each evening of their stay or he will provide dining at one of the local restaurants. Ben's kitchen will be open to the guest to bring & prepare their own food & drinks for break-

fast & lunch. It is also recommended that they provide their own alcoholic beverages. Ben will stay at the cabin with the guests & will either fish with the guests or point them in the right direction for public access sites along the South Branch or the main-stream of the Au Sable River.

The time frame for the trip will be for four nights beginning on April 28 & ending on May 9, 2014. The booking with Ben should be made before March 24, 2014. Ben's contact information will be provided to the sponsors' raffle winner.

Fishing at this time of the year is for brook and brown trout to the blue wing olive or hendrickson hatches. A word of caution however, the South Branch can be very high in the early spring, however the nearby mainstream of the Au Sable & the North Branch of the Au Sable almost always provide wade fishing at this time of the year.

Ben recommends that the guests consider hiring a guide during their stay for at least one of the days. A guide early in their stay could provide a good overview & experience on the different tactics and techniques for fishing the waters of the Au Sable. The Au Sable river system has not been stocked with trout since the 1960's, these trout are wild and can be difficult to catch. A guide would float the river with clients in an Au Sable River Boat & provide lunch for around \$350 plus tip.

At this time of the year a guide could also be hired to fish for Great Lakes Steelhead on the lower Au Sable River, this water is about a 1.5 hour drive from Ben's cabin. Ben can suggest guides for either of these trips. With or without a guide Ben will do his best to capitalize on his over 30 years experience on fishing these waters with the sponsors' raffle winner.
